

## Tissue Paper Butterfly

### Materials Required:

- A4 paper
- Tissue paper in a variety of colours
- PVA glue
- Glue brush

### Instructions:

- Mix some PVA glue with a few drops of water.
- Using the tissue paper, cut a long oval shape for the butterfly's body.
- Cut a circle for the butterfly's head.
- Glue the body and head onto the A4 white paper.
- Tear two colours of tissue paper into large wing shapes and glue them onto the A4 paper (the same pattern on both sides of the butterfly's body).
- Add more wing shapes to add texture by crumpling and overlapping them.
- Cut and/or rip some small shapes for patterns and glue them onto the wings of the butterfly, again matching them on each side for symmetry.
- Using the mixture of PVA glue and water, brush a layer over the butterfly to give it a shiny appearance.
- Allow the glue to dry.
- Using a thin black felt-tip pen, add details to the butterfly.
